



U.S. Premium Beef Facts

- U.S. Premium Beef has averaged approximately 12,000 head of cattle per week from its unitholders and Associates in 36 states since inception in December 1997.
- Cattle are delivered to USPB plants in Liberal and Dodge City, KS and Brawley, CA.
- To date, more than 1,400 feedlots in 14 states have sent cattle through USPB's system.
- During fiscal year 2007, all U.S. Premium Beef cattle earned \$24.61 per head in premiums over the cash market. The top 25 percent received more than \$62 per head in premiums to cash; the top 50 percent earned over \$46 per head premiums while the top 75 percent of USPB cattle have earned more than \$36 per head over selling on the cash market.
- An electronic ID system in National Beef plants makes collecting and receiving individual carcass data, which USPB provides at no additional charge to unitholders and Associates, more efficient. USPB is rebating its unitholders and Associates \$1.00 of the purchase price of electronic identification tags on an as used basis through 2007.
